

# **Healthcare Communication Project Guidelines**

"Explaining Blood Collection to a 6-Year-Old Child & their Parents"

### **Project Overview**

Create a one-page A4 visual guide for healthcare professionals on how to explain blood collection to a young child (with parents' present).

### **Required Elements**

Your one-page guide must include:

- 1. Creative Title (e.g., "Making Blood Tests Less Scary!")
- 2. **Before the Procedure** Preparation tips (3-4 points)
- 3. **During the Procedure** Communication strategies (3-4 points)
- 4. Do's and Don'ts Clear visual presentation
- 5. Child-Friendly Phrases Age-appropriate language examples
- 6. Parent Involvement Tips How to include caregivers
- 7. Visual Elements Simple drawings, icons, or colors
- 8. Team Information Names and creative healthcare roles

### **Design Requirements**

- One A4 page only (portrait or landscape)
- Clear, readable font (minimum 11pt)
- Professional yet child-friendly appearance
- · Balance of text and visuals

- Submit one A4 page per group (PDF format)
- Include all group members' names and IDs
